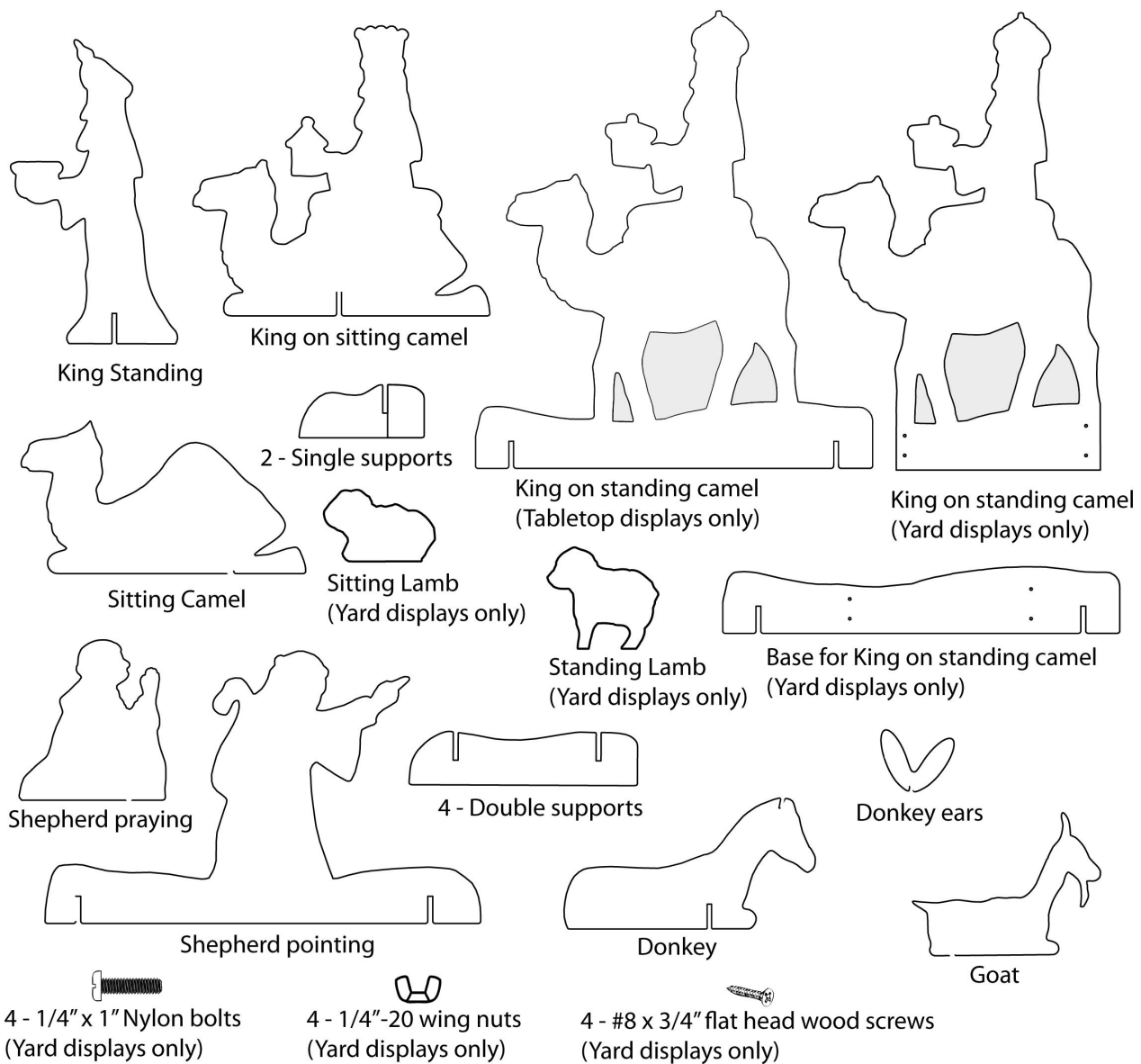


# Assembly Instructions for Yard and Tabletop Accessory Displays

# Assembly

Note: You can connect any combination of Kings, Shepherds, and the animals in creating your scene.  
Below is the recommended setup.

## Kings

- Connect the base to King on Standing Camel with the four ¼" x 1" Nylon Bolts and wing nuts.  
(Yard displays only)
- Connect the back slots of each double support to the slots of the King on Standing Camel.
- Connect the King Standing to the left front slot of the double support.
- Connect the King on Sitting Camel to the right front slot of the double support.

## Shepherds

- Connect the back slots of each double support to the slots of the Shepherd Pointing.
- Connect the Shepherd Praying to the right front slot of the double support.
- Connect the Donkey Ears to the Donkey and then the Donkey to the left front slot of the double support.

## Goat and Sitting Lamb

- Connect the Goat to the slot of the single support, with the double wide piece facing front. Tabletop displays use single thickness supports.
- Screw the Sitting Lamb to the double wide front of the single support. (Yard displays only)

## Camel Sitting and Standing Lamb

- Connect the Camel Sitting to the single support, with the double wide piece facing front. Tabletop displays use single thickness supports.
- Screw the Standing Lamb to the double wide front of the single support. (Yard displays only)
